We all understand the need to have our furnace or the fireplace flue checked by a qualified service technician before winter, but what about space heaters. “Oh, I’ve had this one for years and it works fine, right?” You have a furnace filter that traps lint, dust, animal hair and about anything else that’s floating in the air. *So does your space heater!!!*

Looks good on the outside, right?



Not so much on the inside!!!

No, this is not a pillow, it’s the back side of the heating element.

Unless you disassemble the heater you may never see just how dangerously close you are to a fire.

If your heater has been in use for more than a couple of years this could be you.

Read and follow the manufacturer’s safety information. Have your heater checked by a QUALIFIED service technician if you have any doubts.
