

ORDINANCE NO: 2011-7 (12-14)

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING A CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR HENRY COUNTY, INDIANA, AND REVISING, AMENDING, RESTATING, CODIFYING AND COMPILING CERTAIN EXISTING GENERAL ORDINANCES OF HENRY COUNTY DEALING WITH SUBJECTS EMBRACED IN SUCH CODE OF ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the present general and permanent ordinances of Henry County are inadequately arranged and classified and are insufficient in form and substance for the complete preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Henry County and for the proper conduct of its affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Acts of the Legislature of the State of Indiana empower and authorize Henry County to revise, amend, restate, codify and compile any existing ordinances and all new ordinances not heretofore adopted or published and to incorporate such ordinances into one ordinance in book form; and

WHEREAS, the Henry County Commissioners have authorized a general compilation, revision and codification of the ordinances of Henry County of a general and permanent nature and publication of such ordinance in book form; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of the county and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Henry County that this ordinance take effect at an early date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF HENRY COUNTY, INDIANA:

Section 1. The general ordinances of Henry County as revised, amended, restated, codified, and compiled in book form are hereby adopted as and shall constitute the "Code of Ordinances of the Henry County."

Section 2. Such Code of Ordinances as adopted in Section 1 shall consist of the following Titles:

See Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Section 3. All prior ordinances pertaining to the subjects treated in such Code of Ordinances shall be deemed repealed from and after the effective date of this ordinance except as they are included and reordained in whole or in part in such Code; provided, such repeal shall not affect any offense committed or penalty incurred or any right established prior to the effective date of this ordinance, nor shall such repeal affect the provisions of ordinances levying taxes, appropriating money, annexing or detaching territory, establishing franchises, or granting special rights to certain persons, authorizing public improvements, authorizing the issuance of bonds or borrowing of money, authorizing the purchase or sale of real or personal property, granting or accepting easements, plat or dedication of land to public use, vacating or setting the boundaries of streets or other public places; nor shall such repeal affect any other ordinance of a temporary or special nature or pertaining to subjects not contained in or covered by the Code.

Henry County - Adopting Ordinance

- Section 4. Such Code shall be deemed published as of the day of its adoption and approval by the Board of Commissioners of Henry County and the Henry County Auditor is hereby authorized and ordered to file a copy of such Code of Ordinances in the Office of the Henry County Clerk.
- Section 5. Such Code shall be in full force and effect as provided in Section 6, and such Code shall be presumptive evidence in all courts and places of the ordinance and all provisions, sections, penalties and regulations therein contained and of the date of passage, and that the same is properly signed, attested, recorded, and approved and that any public hearings and notices thereof as required by law have been given.
- Section 6. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of Henry County, and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.
- Section 7. That if there is any conflict between any provision in this Code of Ordinances and any state statute, law, rule, and/or regulation, the State statute, law, rule, and/or regulation shall control and supersede any provision of this Code of Ordinances.
