HEREBY ADVISED THAT:

1. You have the right to know the nature of the allegations against you.

2. I am the Intake Officer for the purpose of conducting this preliminary inquiry which will assist us in making a recommendation as to informally adjust your case; to recommend that a petition be filed; to refer the case to another agency; or to dismiss the case.
3. _____, you have the right to remain silent; anything you say could or may be used against you in judicial proceedings; you have the right to consult with an attorney before talking to me, as the Intake Officer; and you have a right to stop talking at anytime you want;

The parent, guardian, custodian, foster parent or temporary caregiver may dispute any allegations made at the dispositional or other hearing concerning their participation or may dispute any allegations concerning their financial responsibility for any services that would be provided. They may also make a recommendation to the Court and controvert any information in the pre-dispositional report.

You are further advised that the parent, guardian, custodian, foster parent or temporary caregiver of the child may be subjected to the following obligations if the child is adjudicated a delinquent child:

1. The parent, guardian, custodian, foster parent or temporary caregiver may be required to participate in a program of care, treatment or rehabilitation for the child;
2. The parent, guardian, custodian, foster parent or temporary caregiver may be held financially responsible for any services provided for the child or such parent, guardian, custodian, foster parent or temporary caregiver.
